Deckhand



Elin was born in Stockholm, Sweden. She studied a Masters degree in Hospitality Business Management.


Elin joined the yachting industry in 2013 and has worked on a range of boats from size 50-80 m.

Stewardess




Jemma is a bubbly and sociable personality who enjoys having a laugh and spending time with friends.
